Hot Tip

When painting your children’s bedroom, have three walls the same and one feature wall, as they grow you only have to change the feature wall and have a whole new look. If you have the bedrooms side by side and don’t want to be assaulted with color when walking down the hall, have the three walls that you can see while standing in the hall, the same color in both rooms and the feature wall only visible when you step into the room. This

does not mean you have to have white/cream on the three walls, colors such as Taubmans "lawn" (yellowy green) go just as well with a burnt orange (boys) as it does with purple (girls).

Go to the likes of Warehouse Stationery and get a large pin board and paint the frame the same color as the feature wall, place it on the other colored wall to tie it together. Have fun with your kid's rooms, usually it is the one part of the house that your colors and ideas can run riot.
